Who is eligible to apply for the scholarship?

This is an open scholarship for young performers in the valley, ages 8-20 years old. You do not have to be affiliated with The Junior Company or Good Company Players to apply for the scholarship.

What classes are eligible for the scholarship?

Any performing arts classes- such as voice, dance, acting or playing a musical instrument.

What is the amount of the award?

The awarded scholarship will be a one-time payment for the class chosen by the scholarship recipient made out to the establishment or the instructor. The scholarship amount will not exceed \$150 regardless of the cost of the chosen class. This scholarship is meant only to supplement your request should you be taking instruction in a higher value course.

The scholarship does not guarantee you a spot in any class. It is the recipient's responsibility to enroll or register for the class prior to its beginning. Once the registration has been paid, the scholarship funds are non-refundable. You will have until **June 30, 2021** to expend the funds.

How are the winners selected?

Applicants will be judged on clearly stated educational objectives and goals. Judges not currently affiliated with the Junior Company, GCP or the Junior Company Foundation will evaluate each application and corresponding personal essay. Upon completion of the evaluation process, the scores will be provided to the Scholarship Committee. Scholarships will be awarded based solely on those scores.
