Scholarship Information

Who is eligible to apply for the scholarship?

This is an open scholarship for young performers in the valley, ages 8-20 year old. You do not have to be affiliated with The Junior Company or Good Company Players to apply for the scholarship.

All applicants must submit a completed application and a short essay on why you want to take the chosen class. Applications are due **April 15th, 2019**. Recipients will be contacted by **April 19th, 2019**.

What classes are eligible for the scholarship?

What is the amount of the award?

The awarded scholarship will be applied to the registration fee for the class chosen by the scholarship recipient. The scholarship will be awarded up to **\$40.00**.

The scholarship does not guarantee you a spot in the class. It is the recipient's responsibility to enroll in the awarded class prior to it beginning. Please visit the link above for enrollment information. Upon registration, funds are non-refundable.

How are the winners selected?

Applicants will be judged on clearly stated educational objectives and goals. The Scholarship Committee will select the recipients by evaluating each application and corresponding essay. Incomplete applications will be ineligible for review.
